



Psychiatry career opportunities in Scandinavia

Some of the job opportunities in Psychiatry:

General Psychiatrists, Gothenburg city, Västra Götaland, Sweden

There are 2 positions in the Affective Psychiatry Department and 2 in the Addiction Department. Work will be in a multidisciplinary team (both inpatient and outpatient). Reception, diagnosis and treatment of patients, team sessions and meetings with the patient's family, cooperation with social services. In the affective psychiatry clinic they treat patients with affective disorders, including bipolar disorders, anxiety syndromes, compulsive-, eating-, personality-, neuropsychiatric disorders including ADHD and autism spectrum disorder. There are programs for adapting people to the society. The addiction clinic cooperates with the University of Gothenburg and with Socialstyrelsen (national health board). The Hospital has a generous policy regarding further training and participation to conferences.

General Psychiatrist, Kungälv, Västra Götaland Sweden

The department consists of two parts, inpatient and outpatient. There are 4 nursing wards, 1 for psychosis, 1 for addiction disorders and 2 for general psychiatry. The outpatient service is situated in the towns of Ale, Kungälv and Stenungsund. The most common diagnosis at the clinics are affective disorders, OCD, personality disorders, social phobia and eating disorders.

Psychiatrist (bipolar disorders), Gothenburg city, Västra Götaland, Sweden

The University Hospital of Sahlgrenska is looking for psychiatrists specialised/with special interest in bipolar disorders who want to join a team of highly skilled professionals within the Department of Psychiatry for Affective Disorders in their subspecialized outpatient or inpatient clinic for Bipolar disorders.

We offer:

- Permanent contract after obtaining the Swedish medical license.
- Training courses within working hours.
- Help to find: apartment, school and kindergarten.
- Study tour to Sweden, after a first interview, to learn more about the region and the work environment.
- Assistance with removal and relocation costs.

It was a bit difficult at first to understand the dialect that the patients were speaking and I was very tired when I returned home in the evenings. But with some practice and a strong focus on the language it started going better and now, after half a year in Sweden, I understand almost everything and I can have a dialogue with the patients without difficulties.
